HETHERSETT

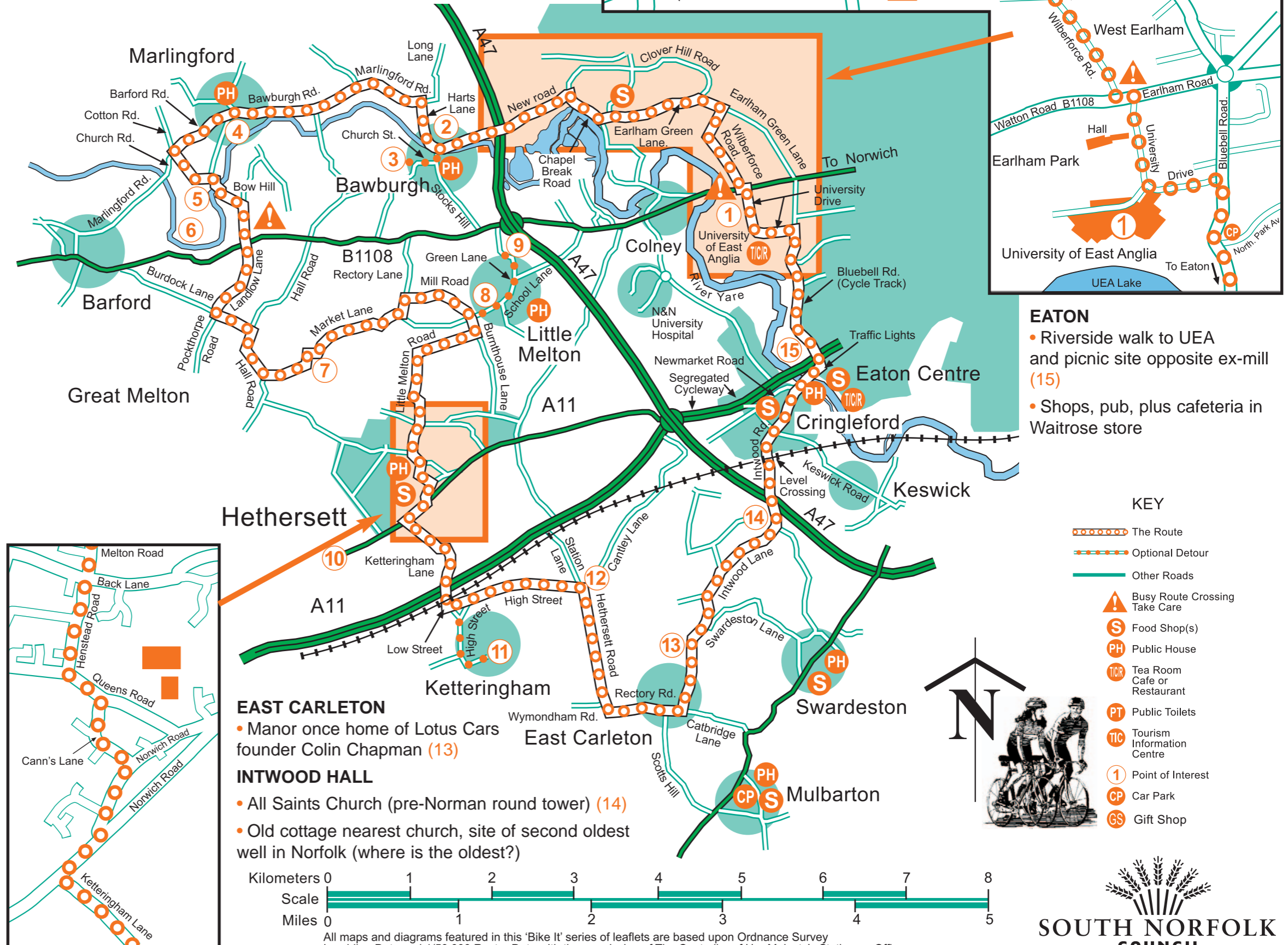
- Shops, pubs, services
- Kett's Oak 1¼ km B1172 to Wymondham (memorial plaque to Robert Kett of Wymondham, leader of Norfolk rebellion against enclosures, hanged Norwich in 1549).(10)

KETTERINGHAM

- Ketteringham Hall (Tudor mansion) (11) (HQ of Norfolk American Air bases in WWII and later a base for the Team Lotus Grand Prix racing car team)
- St Peter's Church (16th century reredos/3 decker pulpit)
- War Memorial

UNIVERSITY OF EAST ANGLIA (1)

- Parkland setting and lake walk.
- Pub and cafeteria.
- Sainsbury Centre (by Norman Foster).
- Stepped terraced residences.
